- 9. To use appropriate equipment and adapt if necessary
- 10. To contribute to the development of University Hockey using specialist knowledge at relevant events such as Freshers Fair, Trails, Welcome Events etc.
- 11. To understand the content, intent and relevant application of UWE Bristol's Safeguarding Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy & Procedures, Equity and other relevant policies/procedures
