Library Services

The well-established library is at the heart of the University. It serves students and staff and aims to deliver the best possible service to all users. It is constantly adapting to embrace the increasing use of technology in learning and teaching. It harnesses the rapid growth in online and electronic publishing and aims to meet the needs of its diverse range of students. The department consists of approximately 130 people.

Academic Services

Academic Services consists of nearly 200 staff whose role is to support all students to enjoy the best possible academic experience. They are involved in improving the learning and teaching, maintaining the student administration processes and systems and ensuring appropriate regulation and governance. They ensure the quality and standards of the University's awards (e.g. diplomas and degrees), and also handle student complaints and appeals.

Student Services

The Student Services department has approximately 300 employees dedicated to providing a range of support to students. The support includes information points around the campus, advice on money matters and fees, emotional and practical support, opportunities to practice a faith and general wellbeing. The service also provides essential support for students with disabilities, enabling them to reach their full potential. As students work towards their qualifications and graduation, the service also provides them with essential careers support, information on volunteering as well as opportunities for placements and internships to support them to take the next step beyond university. Supporting an exceptional student experience is at the heart of everything they do.
