Apprenticeships are changing – are you ready?

From April 2017 all UK employers with a payroll of more than £3 million per year will pay a levy of 0.5% to support apprenticeships.

Employers will be able to 'spend' their Levy on apprenticeships via a digital account. Those whose payroll is less than £3 million will not pay a Levy, but will still have access to funding via a digital account through a 'co-fund mechanism', to support their own degree apprenticeships.
