HNC/HND	Year 2 or Year 3 Undergraduate Degree	Credit or distinction
Bachelor's Degree	Master's Degree	50% or CGPA 2.5 or 2.6

All UWE Bristol students must have a recognised English Language qualification. Our preferred tests include IELTS, Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (CAE) and Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE).
