Entry onto UWE Bristol courses

A guide to acceptable qualifications for each level of study is listed below:

All UWE students must have a recognised English Language qualification. Students who have completed Year 12 in the US with at least a Grade C (75%) in their High School Graduation Diploma English are not required to take an English Language exam.

Please note that an IELTS for UKVI purposes is needed for entry onto the Pre-sessional English programmes.
