Stratford-upon-Avon

Saturday 4 February, leave Frenchay Campus at 08:15, return by 20:00

Cost: £29.80 (including admission fees, cream tea and return coach fare).

Step back in time and visit the beautiful birthplace of Shakespeare, England's most famous playwright. Learn how he grew up in Stratford-upon-Avon with a visit to the Shakespeare Centre. Visit three Tudor houses: Shakespeare's Birthplace, Hall's Croft and Nash's House. Guides will explain Shakespeare's connection with each house. The trip includes time to explore this picturesque town, plus a delicious cream tea.



Stonehenge and Salisbury

Saturday 25 February, leave Frenchay Campus at 08:15, return by 19:00

Cost: £30.80 (including the return coach fare, entry ticket to Stonehenge and the guided tour for the Salisbury Cathedral).

Join us as we visit Stonehenge, erected 3000BC - 1600BC, one of the Wonders of the World and best-known prehistoric monument in Europe. Stonehenge now has a transformed world-class visitor centre, housing museum-quality exhibitions, a shop and café. We then journey to Salisbury for a guided tour of the finest Medieval cathedral in Britain, with the tallest spire in England; plus free time!

Cost: £28.80 (including return the guided tour, entry fees and the return coach fare).

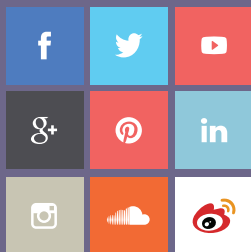
