Your house and study bedroom

- Houses are organised into rooms for groups of six students sharing.
- You'll share a kitchen/lounge room and bathroom facilities.
- All accommodation is provided on a self catering basis.
- All study bedrooms are single occupancy.
- All study bedrooms are provided with Glide internet service.
- Gas, electricity and water bills are included as part of the rent.



Kitchen/lounge

Kitchen facilities comprise of one gas cooker, two fridge/freezers, a kettle and a microwave for six sharing. You'll need to bring your own cooking utensils. Within the lounge area, there is a dining table with stools, easy chairs, a sofa and a coffee table. There is a TV aerial socket.

Study bedroom

All individual study bedrooms have a single bed, wardrobe with hanging space and shelves, a desk with chair, a chest of drawers, a mirror, bedside table, noticeboard and bookshelves. The rooms are fully carpeted and curtained. There are no TV aerial sockets in the bedrooms.

Bathroom facilities

The ground floor shower room consists of a shower cubicle, basin and WC. The upstairs bathroom comprises a bath and basin. A separate WC is also located upstairs.

Heating

The houses have gas central heating. You can control the temperature in your study bedroom, during heating times, by adjusting the individual thermostat control on the radiator.

Heating times are regulated centrally by the University. Normal provision is weather dependent but as a guide:

Winter (November to March):

07:00 to 11:00 then 17:00 to 00:00


Autumn and Spring (October and April):

07:00 to 09:00 then 19:00 to 22:00

Summer (May to September):

Heating is switched off.

Other facilities

Launderette

There are launderette facilities in the Student Village and you have access to all three in Brecon, Mendip and Quantock Pavilion. This facility is operated with the use of a mobile app, or laundry card if you don't have a smart phone.

Prices start at £2.20 for an eco wash and £1.20 for dryers.

Car parking

If you live on Frenchay campus there are no parking facilities for residents. We work closely with the council, police and local residents to ensure that students do not park in nearby residential areas, promoting good community relations with our neighbours. It is also a condition of your Licence to Occupy not to bring a car with you to University.

The University does however provide parking for blue badge holders.

Visitors parking

Visitors parking is available via a 'Pay on Exit' system.

From 09:00 - 17:00 Monday - Friday it's £5 for up to 4 hours or £10.00 for the day.

It's free to park outside of these times (Monday - Friday 17:00 - 09:00 and weekends).

Parking for motorbikes and mopeds

There is designated parking on campus for motorbikes and mopeds in Car parks 3, 4, 15 and 17, accessible at Northavon house via the East entrance on Frenchay Campus. No permit is required.

Bicycle storage

There is lockable covered bike storage within the Frenchay Student Village - please ask Cotswold Court Customer Service Desk for access. Bikes must not be stored inside the house. We recommend the use of a good quality bicycle lock.

Mail

Please ensure that all mail is properly addressed to include your house number.

- Each house has its own postbox situated externally in Carroll Court.
- If you are not at home, post requiring a signature on delivery will be delivered to Quantock Court Post Room and can then be collected.
- Please do not sign for receipt of other people's mail - it should only be collected by the addressee.
- It is an offence to open other people's mail.

The University cannot accept liability for any items of mail that fail to reach the addressee.

Shopping

On Frenchay Campus there are three convenience stores - the Students' Union Shop in the Students' Union building, the Village Store at the Centre for Sport and the SU shop in the centre of the campus. They stock essentials such as milk and toiletries as well as stationery, newspapers, drinks and snacks. There are several cash points on campus and a fresh fruit and veg stall.

Within walking distance of Carroll Court there are several supermarkets (ASDA, Lidl and Sainsbury's) and homeware, clothing and food outlets at Abbey Wood Shopping Park. Shopping trolleys must not be removed from supermarket premises or brought onto campus. Fold up trolleys can be purchased from the UWE online store.

There are frequent bus services to Bristol City Centre and the large Regional Shopping Centre at Cribbs Causeway (The Mall).

Access and loss of keys

Access to a Carroll Court house is by an access fob which opens the front door and a key which opens your bedroom door. You will also be issued with access for using the launderette and bike store in the Student Village via your fob. If you lose your fob/key card/key, replacements will be provided by Accommodation Services for which you will be charged. These can be obtained via Cotswold Customer Service Desk.

Please do not keep your property address with your keys as this is a security risk and do not lend your access card to anyone-else.

You can go to Cotswold Court Customer Service Desk in the adjacent Student Village for all enquiries.

Accommodation managers

Accommodation Managers are available from 08:00-18:00 Monday to Friday with pre-booked meetings outside of these times and can help you with day-to-day management of your accommodation. You can get in contact with them via the Customer Service Desk or a Resident assistant.

Resident assistants

These are students who live within the accommodation to help you settle in and adjust to University life.
