Funding Support Explained

If you secure a place on the project, you may be able to access the following funding support.

- 1. UWE Global Water Security Project funding > £500
- 2. UWE Go Global Bursary Water Security Project Scheme > £500/£1000
- 3. Student Finance Travel Grant > Varying amounts

Below we explain these different funding courses

UWE Global Water Security Project funding

All student successfully placed on the project will receive a grant of £500 to help towards the cost of the project. This is money for you to spend as you wish e.g. flights, vaccinations, visas etc.

We are also assisting the host organisation in awarding them a small amount of financial support for the cost of hosting you. Hosts <u>may</u> be able to offer additional benefits in kind but this will be confirmed at the point of securing a place of the project.

<u>UWE Go Global Bursary - Water Security Project scheme</u>

The UWE Go Global Bursary offers financial assistance to UWE Bristol undergraduate students who are looking to work or volunteer abroad.

An amount of the Go Global Bursary has been allocated to the UWE Global Water security Project through funding from Santander Universities and UWE Bristol.

This bursary is <u>on top of any funding offered by the UWE Global Water Security Project</u> and is aimed at helping you with the costs of participating in the Project only.

The eligibility criteria for this bursary is slightly different to the main UWE Go Global Bursary scheme and the payment could be an amount of £500 or £1000, depending on your personal circumstances.

Who can apply for the UWE Go Global Bursary - Water Security Project scheme?

Eligibility

To see if you are eligible for the bursary, please initially note the following criteria:

- You are a UWE Bristol undergraduate student
- You are a home student. If you are unsure of your student status please view information on how to <u>determine your fee status</u>
- Your global opportunity lasts at least two weeks
- You have been means tested for your student funding for the 2016-17 academic year or you receive maintenance grant.
- You are a current UK domiciled undergraduate student at the point of applying for the bursary. We will accept applications from current final year students but you need to have applied before 14 July 2017 and started the international opportunity by 1 January 2018.

Students will also need to have:

- registered for the <u>UWE Futures Award</u> (if eligible)
- fully researched the overseas opportunity, even when it has been advertised via UWE Bristol
- agreed to share updates from your time abroad (via social media or blogs) and provide these to the Go Global team

Exclusions

The bursary will not be available to the following:

- part-time students
- postgraduate students
- non-Home students
- students going overseas to participate in a UWE Study Abroad exchange programme with integrated work experience
- retrospective applications
