

Vice Chancellor's Scholarship - Terms and Conditions 2019/20

Student Eligibility

- Students must have a fee status of either Home or EU
- Students must:
 - either be in their final year of a UWE Bristol undergraduate degree in 2018/19 academic year,
 - or, have completed a full-time or part-time UWE Bristol undergraduate degree in 2017/18 academic year.
- Students must progress from their UG course to an eligible full time or part time postgraduate taught or professional course at UWE Bristol starting between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020.
- Where scholarship places are limited, the student will have 14 days (or the course start date if this falls before 14 days) to confirm their acceptance of their scholarship place. Without confirmation by the student the scholarship place will be reallocated.
- Students who are fully sponsored for their tuition fees by their employer or by a professional body are not eligible for the Scholarship.
- Students who are partly sponsored will have the discount applied to the balance of the fees outstanding after sponsorship.
- Applicants must have no outstanding debt to the University at Registration.
- Students must be willing and able to participate in some kind of recruitment or conversion related activity during their course.

Course Eligibility

- There are specific courses that attract the Vice Chancellor's Scholarship. These are subject to change but any changes will not affect scholarships that have already been offered or awarded. A current list of eligible courses can be found on the University website via the link below.
- Courses that are validated but not taught by UWE Bristol are not eligible for this discount.
- The course can be a part-time or full-time.
- There are a limited number of scholarships for some of the courses and for others there is no cap.
- Where scholarships are limited, they will be allocated on a first come, first served basis determined by the date of the student's application to the PG course.

Payment of the Scholarship

- The scholarship is paid as a tuition fee discount and applied at the point of registration on the course.
- Your tuition fees will be reduced by 50% when you register.
- The scholarship includes the 15% alumni discount.

- The discount will be applied at the start of the course for full-time students. Part-time students will receive the discount at the start of each new fee liability period.
- The University reserves the right to cancel any scholarship which has been claimed fraudulently or dishonestly and to apply the full tuition fee.

Changes post-registration

- Where a student terminates or interrupts their studies, prior to the completion of their course, both the tuition fees and scholarship will be pro-rated, based on the student's last date of attendance.
- Where a student breaks University regulations and is expelled, suspended or excluded from the University, the scholarship will be immediately terminated and no further support will be available. If the student returns to study at a later date, the scholarship will not be re-awarded.
- The scholarship does not apply for fees arising from repeat study.
- The scholarship is not transferable to a new eligible course unless there are available scholarships for that course.
- The scholarship is not transferable to an ineligible course.
- The scholarship will not be paid if you choose to transfer to a different course at the university that is excluded from the Vice Chancellor's Scholarship.

Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the University and UWE Bristol reserves the right to revise, review or withdraw the scheme at any time without prior notice. This will not affect any scholarships that have already been offered or awarded.
