Before you arrive

Joining instructions

Before your course starts, you will be sent course-specific joining instructions. These instructions will tell you when and where you need to register, when your course induction is and any pre-arrival preparation you might need to do before coming to UWE.

Online registration

Now that you are able to access [myUWE](#), click the registration tab and you will be guided through the online registration service which will allow you to register and make arrangements to pay your fees. You will also need to upload a photo for your UWE ID card.

Paying your fees

The second part of your online registration requires you to specify who will be paying your fees and the method of payment.

If you have applied for a tuition fee loan, you don't need to make any payments. The university will update this information once your funding details have been received from the Student Loans Company.

If you are paying your fees yourself you need to either pay the full sum as a one off payment or select one of the instalment options.

Collecting your UWE ID Card

As long as you've uploaded a photo on to myUWE before you arrive, you can collect your UWE ID card at your registration session. Just make sure you bring some photo ID with you so we know who you are. Your passport, driving licence or UK/EU identity card will work.

Induction Week

The first week (14 - 18 September) includes essential things like enrolling on your course and getting all the information you need to start your studies, as well as plenty of opportunities to make friends and explore the local area.

Your course sessions are compulsory. It may be tempting to be out all night, but make sure you are attending any timetabled sessions or you'll fall behind.
