Description

EDEM was founded in 2002 and by regional business leaders with the intention of producing the next generation of entrepreneurs and successful business leaders. Incoming exchange students are welcomed to EDEM with an orientation programme to introduce them to the institution, the city and Spanish life. The University provides opportunities to visit companies and meet entrepreneurs. Facilities at the campus, located in the heart of Valencia's marina, include a cafeteria and a 24/7 library.

Surrounding Area

Valencia is Spain's third largest city. Described by the the Lonely Planet as a 'wonderful liveable city with thriving cultural, eating and nightlife scenes', it is filled with striking contemporary architecture. The city is home to great museums, a long stretch of beach and a characterful old quarter. It is well-known for being the home of the Spanish national dish, Paella.



Accommodation

EDEM Valencia provides support and information for students in finding private accommodation and accessing student residences in Valencia. Accommodation costs between EUR200-350 for a room in a shared flat, and EUR400-1000 for a student residence.
