## Description

JAMK is a triple accredited business school in one of the most popular student cities in Finland. Every year 20 new businesses are founded at the university and practical training in compulsory on almost all courses. The business school offers a variety of interactive learning methods, including online learning so students receive a more personalised teaching experience from their professors.

## Surrounding Area

Jyväskylä is a small city in south central Finland, right in the heart of the Finnish Lakeland. It is known as the Athens of Finland due to the city's major role as an educational centre. It hosts an annual art festival, a segment of the world rally championship and residents can see the work of Finland's most famous architect, Alvar Aalto, throughout the city. It has a large student population with 1 in 4 of its residents being students.

## Accommodation

Furnished rooms in shared accommodation with shared bathroom and kitchen area are available through KOAS (Finnish student housing association). Accommodation must be rented for the entire semester or year.
