Typical modules studied in Alicante include architectural composition, urban planning, and computerised design.

Students arriving in the dynamic, attractive, provincial city can expect frenetic, typically Spanish nightlife and excellent weather. Many examples of historic architecture such as the Baroque Casa de La Application deadline: 15th June Asegurada (1685), the most ancient civil building in the city. Today it is home to the Museum of Contemporary Art of Alicante.
