This web page provides an entry point to the following two resources for careers guidance:

- **Library Catalogue**

This is the best source of information about the books and journals (magazines), both print and electronic, available in any UWE library. It does not require a username or password to search the catalogue but you may be asked to confirm that you are from the University of the West of England.

- **Finding journal articles: eLibrary (Databases)**

The eLibrary enables you to identify journal articles for your subject. You will need to log in using your UWE network username and password (select 'Education' from the list of subjects at the web page above). eLibrary includes databases such as British Education Index and Education Research Complete.

Many of these resources are password protected, particularly for use outside the university. Your UWE network username and password will allow you to access most of them. In this way, you will be recognised as an official UWE member and should not encounter any access problems. The first time that you login to a resource you will probably be asked to confirm that you are a UWE member.
