

French Language Library Resources

<p>Newspapers</p>	<p>Print: The Library subscribes to two daily French newspapers, Le Monde and Libération. The current issues are at the back of Level 2.</p> <p>Electronic: The database Nexis gives full-text access to a large number of French newspapers and magazines, including Le Figaro, L'Humanité and La Tribune. You can access this at http://www.uwe.ac.uk/library/elibrary/. You will need your UWE network username and password.</p>
<p>Magazines</p>	<p>There are several French language magazines available in the Library. The current issues can be found on Level 3 by the comfy seating area and are for reference only. They include L'Express, Le Nouvel Observateur, L'Histoire, Le Point, Label France and Première.</p>
<p>Film DVDs</p>	<p>The Library has a large range of French language films on Level 5 which can be borrowed. You can also view them on one of the televisions in the Library. Examples include Bienvenue les Ch'tis, Etre et avoir, Les Choristes, La Vie en Rose, The Class and Les Visiteurs.</p> <p>For a full list of films visit the web page given at the top of this guide.</p>
<p>Grammar books, Dictionaries and Language packs</p>	<p>Print: Grammar books and language packs are on Level 4. They can be found at shelf number 445 and can be borrowed. The Library has a subscription to Authentik, which contains sound excerpts from the French news, along with accompanying articles from the press.</p> <p>If you would like to use a language pack in the library there are computers available in the PC lab 4D29. You may need headphones and these can be borrowed from the Short Loan Area on Level 2.</p> <p>Electronic: The Library has access to Oxford Language Dictionaries Online, which includes a bilingual French-English dictionary. You can access this at http://www.uwe.ac.uk/library/elibrary/. You will need your UWE network username and password.</p>
