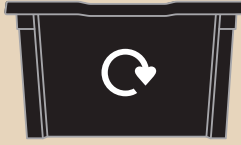

# Recycling and Composting



Use the Green Box for plastic, cans and tins, plastic bottles and food packaging cardboard and Tetra Paks

(no black plastic or plastic bags please)



Use the Black Box for glass, paper and batteries  
(No broken glass or plastic bags please)



Use the Brown Bin for food waste  
(no plastic bags please)

## Remember!

The boxes and bin are collected from the front of your property each week on your collection day as normal.

# Landfill Waste

Normally Bristol City Council collects landfill waste every two weeks, but because you are moving out we have arranged for more collections for your property from the 18th June to the 2nd July 2012. Please use the special red sacks provided to indicate you are part of this special collection scheme.



## Quick “How to” guide...

Place the red sacks in your front garden, or neatly on the pavement in front of your property if you don't have a garden, for collection by Bristol City Council.
