### Description

KU Leuven was established in 1425 by Pope Martin V. KU Leuven has Erasmus agreements with 434 European Institutions and welcomes around 500 exchange students and 7000 International students every year. There is an active local Erasmus Student Network (ESN) which provides support and social activities. KU Leuven organises orientation days in February and September and offers a buddy system to exchange students to aid their language skills.

### Surrounding Area

KU Leuven is located 25km from Brussels in Flanders, the Dutch-speaking northern part of Belgium. Leuven and the surrounding region is famous for Belgian beer, which can be enjoyed at numerous cafes, on Brewery visits, or at beer workshops. Students make up over 50% of the local population and the city is small enough that most distances can be covered by foot or bicycle.
