Description

Politecnico di Milano (Polimi) is a specialist institution offering courses in Architecture, Engineering and Design. It is partnered with around 500 universities internationally and welcomes 1000 international exchange students every year. Polimi's active Erasmus Student Network (ESN) organises events, language exchanges, and out-oftown trips and provide advice on accommodation to ensure visiting students feel welcome and supported during their studies in Italy.

Surrounding Area
