Description

Rennes School of Business is a global School of Management in France in Brittany. All of its programmes are taught in English and 50% of its students are international. It has a network of 260 partner Universities worldwide and triple EQUIS, AACSM and AMBA accreditation.

Despite its relatively small size, the School has a modern and well-equipped campus boasting social facilities, a cafeteria, language laboratory, library and gymnasium.

Rennes School of Business operates an airport pick-up service at the start of term from nearby airports and train stations.

Surrounding Area

Rennes is an ancient medieval city in the heart of the picturesque province of Brittany in north west France. The tenth largest city in France, it is a significant digital innovation centre home to 63,000 students. It is 1.5 hours from Paris by train and 1

hour's flight from London. Brittany is well known for a coastline that includes dramatic clifftops and rock formations as well as secluded sandy bays.

Accommodation

The University's own student accommodation is just 5 minutes from campus. Private accommodation options include shared flats, studio, home stay or state student hostels. Expect to budget between EUR350-500 per month including bills.
