Description

This medium sized institution consists of two faculties – Design and Fine Arts, and has links with a number of fine art institutions across Europe. UWE has been sending students to Zokei since 2005. The University itself was established in 1966 in Hachioji, Tokyo, by a fashion journalist and designer. The campus is home to it's own museum, numerous workshop/studio areas, as well as social and exhibition spaces.

Surrounding Area

Hachioji is the eighth largest city in the Greater Tokyo Area and the city is surrounded on three sides by mountains. Local attractions include Mt. Takao and Mt. Jinba, as well as the Fuji art museum. Central Tokyo is around 1 hour from the campus by public transport.

Accommodation

Privately arranged - Tokyo Zokei will provide a list of private landlords that students can contact. Costs range from £450-600 per month.
