Description

The Universidad De Valladolid is one of the leading centres of Higher Education in Spain. The international office offers two orientation days giving students advice about everything from police registration and enrolment to Spanish courses. Nursing students studying at this institution undertake clinical placements in a hospital setting whilst on exchange allowing them the opportunity to gain specialist skills in a professional healthcare environment outside of the UK.

Surrounding Area

The historic centre of Valladolid, is home to an interesting collection of Renaissance buildings comprising houses, palaces, churches, and one of its most emblematic buildings, its cathedral. The city has an intense cultural schedule thanks to its status as a university town, and hosts events such as the Seminci, the International Film Festival.

Accommodation

The university helps students find accommodation before they arrive based on their preference of living in university accommodation or with a Spanish family.

- Complete and print an online application form
- Submit a language certificate of B1 Spanish (applicants will be given access to UWE's online language support system to support and assess their language learning).
- 1 passport photo, copy of passport
