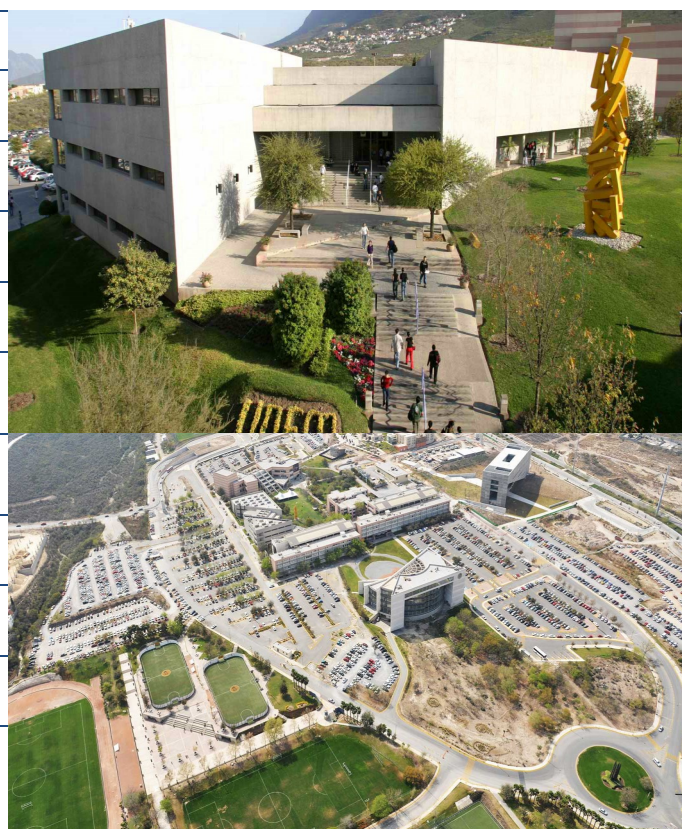

Description

UDEM is a private University in Monterrey, Mexico with a longstanding relationship with UWE. UDEM's large campus provides all the facilities and support services to be expected of a large, internationally focussed University. It includes a bookstore, sports centre, library, and cafeterias. A free bus service provides transport to the University.

Surrounding Area

Monterrey is Mexico's leading industrial city and has more than 4 million inhabitants. Museums, art galleries, music venues and theatres, tourist and shopping centres, ecological parks, and more than 80 public and private sport centres make up part of the infrastructure of Mexico's third largest city. The Universidad de Monterrey is located in one of the most prosperous suburbs of the metropolitan area of Monterrey, capital of the state of Nuevo León.

Accommodation

University accommodation is provided through Residencias UDEM and includes internet, study halls, air-con, gym and laundry. The 'Buscar Hogar' service is available to support international students who prefer private accommodation.

How to apply

When successfully selected by UWE and nominated to UDEM, you will need to return the requested documentation by early May (for students commencing studies in August).

Visas & Immigration

Students studying for a semester or a year will require a visa. Passports will need to have 3 months validity after the end of studies; and applicants will need to show sufficient funding for their stay in Mexico. See [here](#) for more information.
