Description

The University of Turku is an international research university which strives to provide high-quality education. It has students, teachers and researchers with 95 different nationalities.

The University of Turku has established a tutor system for exchange students. This system engages voluntary and trained Finnish students to help incoming exchange students with practical matters and to guide them into student life in Turku. The tutors - Finnish student volunteers - each have about 3-5 exchange students.

Surrounding Area

Turku is a beautiful 13th century town and the oldest city in Finland. It remains a regional capital and an important business and cultural centre. The main sights include the cobbled walkways and restaurants along the Aura riverfront, the market square, and the castle and cathedral museums. Turku is a vibrant modern city with many events and things to do.



Accommodation

Subsidised housing alternatives are on offer by Student Housing Foundation TYS, and Retrodorm and private accommodation as well.

How to apply

When successfully selected by UWE Bristol and nominated to Turku, you will need to:

1. Fill in the Electronic Application Form
2. Submit a Transcript of Records, and Certificate of Exchange Status (=nomination)
3. Wait for the Turku International Office to send you the Certificate of Admission
4. Check the housing options and apply for accommodation
5. Arrange other practicalities (e.g. insurance, travel, residence permit)

Application deadline: 31st of May.
